## CHILD LURES PREVENTION PROGRAM PERMISSION FORM 2019/2020

The Diocese of Saginaw has mandated the protection of children in our parishes, schools, and religious education programs. One form of protection is age appropriate education. The Diocese of Saginaw has adopted the Child Lures Prevention Program: Safe Environment Education as designed by Ken Wooden to be given by a trained educator over the course of several years from Pre/K 1-2; Grades 3-4-5-6, and Grades 7-8.
